- 1. ChatGPT (by OpenAI)
 - 1. Visit https://chat.openai.com.
 - 2. Click "Sign up" and create an account (Gmail recommended).
 - 3. Follow the setup process and log in.
- 2. Gemini (by Google) (Requires a Google Account or Gmail address)
 - 1. Visit https://gemini.google.com.
 - 2. Click "Sign in" and log in with your Google account.
- 3. Microsoft Copilot (Requires a Microsoft 365 account and email)
 - 1. Visit https://copilot.microsoft.com.
 - 2. Click "Sign in" using a Microsoft account (Outlook, Hotmail, or create one if needed).
